**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute to HB 1219 prohibits state agencies from using state funds to organize or endorse any event, official communication, or educational program that promotes LGBTQI Pride Month. The measure also prohibits flags that represent sexual orientation or gender identity from being displayed by an agency on state property.

**CHANGES IN FLOOR SUBSTITUTE VERSION FROM COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE**

Removes language allowing only flags pursuant to federal and state law to be displayed by an agency on state property and replaces it with language prohibiting flags that represent sexual orientation or gender identity from being displayed by an agency on state property.

**Fiscal Analysis**

As amended, HB 1219 prohibits the use of state funds for designated purposes and prohibits the display of certain flags on state property. The measure does not mandate any expenditure by a state agency, and any required action at the agency level is expected to be absorbable through existing agency resources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
