**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendments to HB 1257 allow a person to file a complaint with the Construction Industries Board when a roofing contractor unlawfully offers a homeowner compensation for hiring them. All complaints must be open to the public and forwarded to the Insurance Department, the Attorney General, and the district attorney.
