Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB 1277 codify the reasons for which the State Board of Education may revoke or suspend a teacher's license. The measure prohibits the State Board of Education from revoking or suspending a teacher's license without first going through due process, unless there's an emergency as defined in the Administrative Procedures Act. The SBE is also required to:

- Notify a teacher and the school superintendent of any investigation into a teacher; and
- Notify a teacher and the school district via mail and email within three days of filing an application to revoke a teacher's license.
