**Research Analysis**

HB 1287, as introduced, authorizes the State Board of Regents to create a math tutoring pilot program within OU's College of Education. The program will provide math help to the lowest performing ninth grade students from the state's largest public school districts.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure as currently written is not anticipated to result in a negative fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations. However, OU officials estimate that this pilot program will have an impact of approximately \$3 million. Similar programs in other cities in recent years that are providing this high-dosage tutoring have cost approximately \$3,800 per student receiving these services.
