Research Analysis

The policy committee substitute to HB 1322 creates the Persistent Domestic Violence Offenders Registration Act and requires the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to create a registry of persons convicted of a domestic violence offense who has at least one prior conviction for a domestic violence offense who are directed by the court to register. The measure requires person subject to registration to pay a \$150 to the court clerk with \$50 being retained by the court clerk and \$100 remitted to the OSBI. Persons must remain on the registry for 5 years if the offender only has one prior conviction or for 7 years if the person has two prior convictions. Three convictions require a 10 year registration. Four or more prior offenses subjects the person to 20 years of registration.
