## **Fiscal Analysis**

The conference committee report to HB 1422 restores title and enacting clause to the measure. Upon review, there is no change to the current fiscal analysis of the measure.

The committee substitute to HB 1422 increases the bonding authority of the Grand River Dam Authority (GRDA) to Three Billion Six Hundred Million Dollars (\$3,600,000,000). This increase would allow for additional capital expenditures and increased debt service requirements for GRDA that would be covered by the agency's internal budgetary resources; therefore, this measure has no direct fiscal impact to state appropriations.
