The committee substitute to HB 1462 directs the court to prioritize payments for restitution to the victim when sentencing and until the payment of restitution and the office of the district attorney certifies that restitution is paid in full.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The CS to HB1462 directs the courts to prioritize orders of payments of restitution to victims in certain cases until the Office of the District Attorney certifies that the restitution is paid in full.
