**Research Analysis**

The Floor Substitute for HB 1491 authorizes a member of the State Board of Education to place an item on the Board's agenda if two Board members have provided written request for the item. The item must be placed on the agenda for the next meeting, or a subsequent meeting, as determined by the requesting members.

The Floor sub also authorizes members of district school boards to place items on agendas upon written request. For boards of five or more members, the agenda item requires a written request from two members. For school boards with four or fewer members, just one member may place an item on an agenda upon written request. For the purposes of this subsection, the calculation of the number of members of a board shall exclude any vacant positions.

**DIFFERENCES BETWEEN COMMITTEE SUB AND FLOOR SUB**

The Floor Sub (FA2) adds language allowing members of local school boards to add agenda items upon written request.
