Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 1666 amends the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Prevention act to add that any grading or maintenance of county roads that does not change the existing road grade or ditch flow line will not be deemed excavation. The grading or maintenance of county roads that doesn't change the road grade or ditch flow line is also added to the exception on the prohibition on using powered or mechanized equipment directly over marked routes of underground facilities.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 1666 modifies the definition of *excavate* in the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Preventions Act and provides an exception for the use of powered or mechanized equipment directly over marked routes of underground facilities. The provisions of this measure have no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
