Research Analysis

HB 1681 provides that any person confined in a county jail for aggravated trafficking who requires medical care and treatment in a hospital facility and is released from jail on his or her own recognizance shall not be subject to GPS monitoring while receiving medical care and treatment in the hospital. Upon discharge from the hospital, the person shall be required to have a GPS monitoring device attached within forty-eight hours.
