**Research Analysis**

The Senate Amendments to HB 1684 allows any military surplus vehicle to be tagged and operated on streets and highways in Oklahoma. The measure provides that the owner of any military surplus vehicle that, due to the age of the vehicle, was unable to receive a tag after November 1, 2022 is not to be assessed any penalty for having an expired registration.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 1684 provides that the owner of any military surplus vehicle that, due to the age of the vehicle, was unable to receive a tag after November 1, 2022 is not to be assessed any penalty for having an expired registration. The measure does not materially alter the prior fiscal impact statement. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
