Research Analysis

HB 1691, as introduced, requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to work with the State Fire Marshal to develop guidelines that allow family child care homes and large child care homes to operate under the fire protection requirements of the International Residential Code. These child care homes will not be denied a license should they comply. No political subdivision can place stricter fire requirements than those outlined in the International Residential Code.

Fiscal Analysis
