**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 1767 requires all county offices to provide any forms necessary for citizens to conduct county business or legal proceedings with the county office or court, both physically and on their county website. County offices must also have a notary public available during business hours. County offices are not allowed to charge for the printing of forms or for notary public services. Lastly, the measure requires all county offices and courts to offer credit cards as a form of payment for transactions. County offices and courts are allowed to charge credit card service fees to the person paying for the transaction.
