The policy recommendation to HB 1776 establishes that no state or local governmental entity is to prohibit a person from displaying, whether by vehicle, motorcycle, or by holding, the United States of America flag or the Oklahoma State flag on such state or local governmental entity's property. Flags must be displayed in accordance with accepted standards for proper display and cannot be altered or defaced.

Fiscal Analysis

The policy recommendation to HB 1776 does not materially alter the prior fiscal impact statement. The measure prohibits the restriction by certain entities of the display of certain flags by any person under certain circumstances.
