HB 1816, as introduced, clarifies that in the law that provides that the state Medicaid will contract with an out-of-state medical provider for treatment available in state that "treatment" refers to services that require the physical presence of the patient and the direct care of the medical provider. Services conducted remotely, including lab analysis and diagnostic processing, are not considered treatment under this.
