Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB1850 establishes the Oklahoma Uniform Trust Code and is a uniform law developed by the Uniform Law Commission. The measure is a <u>comprehensive</u> <u>codification</u> of the common law on trusts and establishes default rules that apply when the terms of a trust fails to address a particular issue. The act is meant to complement existing law on trusts, including the Oklahoma Trust Act.
