Research Analysis

The second proposed policy committee substitute for HB1889 provides an inflated-adjusted retirement benefit for certain retired firefighters and police officers, known as Tweeners, who retired between May 26, 1983, and November 1, 1989. A Tweener is a retiree who did not qualify for automatic benefit adjustments granted to those eligible for retirement before May 26, 1983. Tweeners also did not have the opportunity to participate in deferred option plans, which were introduced after November 1, 1989.

The benefit adjustment will be calculated as follows:

adjusted benefit = Starting pension × (CPI-U as of July in year of initial retirement) ÷ (CPI-U as of July 1, 2026)

The measure also includes a safe harbor amendment to allow the bill to be considered a nonfiscal retirement bill, bypassing the requirement of the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis Act.
