HB 1938, as introduced, requires public school students in grades 3-12 to take an annual fitness test. The measure lists specific requirements for the test. Anonymous results must be submitted to the State Department of Health. The Health Department, in consultation with the State Department of Education, must analyze the results for any correlation between physical fitness and academic achievement.
