**Research Analysis**

HB 2035, as introduced, defines *transportation protection agreement* in the Funeral Services Licensing Act as an agreement that primarily provides for all services related to the preparation of remains for transportation. A transportation protection agreement is not considered funeral service merchandise or services and is exempt from the requirements of the Funeral Services Licensing Act and the Oklahoma Insurance Code.
