**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 2059 requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) to partner with the University of Oklahoma Health and Sciences Center to provide medication to detainees and inmates under the jurisdiction of a municipality or county, not the Department of Corrections. OHCA will directly pay the Center for this medication and will promulgate rules for implementation.
