**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB2100 exempts private lands that are entered into the Cost-Share Program from eminent domain. Exemptions to this will only be granted for eminent domain projects that are essential to safeguarding public health, including projects which involve the transmission or distribution of electricity or natural gas.
