## **Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2156 creates setback requirements for solar energy facilities and industrial battery storage facilities. The facilities must be:

- 500 feet away from any occupied structure or occupied residence, unless waived by the occupant;
- 50 feet away from the outer boundary of the solar or battery facility property;
- 100 feet away from the center line of any public road; and
- 1/2 mile from any public school, or hospital.

The measure applies to any 10 megawatt or larger solar or battery facility, and any project in development that does not have a power purchase agreement in place by the effective date of the act.
