Research Analysis

The Senate Amendments to HB 2160 makes numerous changes to the regulation of the franchise agreements of new motor vehicles and powersport vehicles. The measure includes factories as an entity to be regulated. The measure clarifies new powersports dealers and salespersons as regulated entities. The measure removes new powersports dealerships from the provisions which require refusal when the franchise is subject to sale. The measure outlines conditions of sale of a dealership when more than one dealership is owned in whole or in part by the selling dealer. The measure requires written notice of intent to exercise right of first refusal. The measure outlines procedures regarding the treatment of deficiencies during compliance periods prior to any termination of agreement.
