**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 2263 prohibits the operator of a motor vehicle from using or holding of a hand-held electronic cellular device in school zone or work zone. Punishment is a fine of not more than \$100. Municipalities are authorized to enact ordinances relating to this conduct. The Department of Public Safety may not assess points for violation and law enforcement is prohibited from confiscating or extracting information from the cellular device without consent.
