HB 2268, as introduced, provides that the Oklahoma Medicaid Program or contracted entity must provide reimbursement for such benefits delivered through cognitive assessment and care planning services.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2268 requires the state Medicaid program and its contracted entities to provide reimbursement for cognitive assessment and care planning services. According to OHCA officials, with a higher utilization rate of 25% to 50%, the projected state share ranges from One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$189,621) to Seven Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars (\$758,484). Assuming a lower utilization of 10% to 15%, the state share is estimated to be between Seventy-Three Thousand Nine Hundred Five Dollars (\$73,905) to One Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$147,811).

Therefore, HB 2268 could have a fiscal impact of up to \$758,484 on the state budget.
