Research Analysis

The floor substitute to HB 2299 prohibits the Legislature from taking action on a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution resulting from a constitutional convention if the proposed amendment is not related to the subject matter authorized to be considered at the constitutional convention.

CHANGES IN FLOOR SUBSTUTITE VERSION FROM COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE:

The floor substitute version removes the language defining an Article V Convention commissioner, the scope of their authority, and any related criminal penalties and replaces it with language prohibiting the Legislature from taking action on certain proposed amendments to the Oklahoma Constitution.
