**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB2590 requires the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to create a form for state agencies to use to evaluate prospective vendors for a contract to manage federal funds. The form must ask the vendor to list the following information:

- its legal name and other trade or nick names;
- its state of incorporation;
- the names of its principal officers;
- a description of its prior experience in management of federal fund;
- a recent copy of its financial audits; and
- any pending civil litigation where the vendor is named as the defendant.

Agencies must submit completed forms to OMES, the Governor and the Legislature.

**Fiscal Analysis**

After communication with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES), the proposed committee substitute to HB 2590 does not materially alter the prior fiscal impact statement. Implementation of the measure by the OMES Central Purchasing Division would likely require one additional FTE with a salary of \$70,000. The estimated cost for the additional OMES FTE with benefits included is anticipated to total less than \$100,000. Other state agencies would likely require additional compliance staff for implementation of the measure. The total to other agencies for such staff is anticipated to be less than \$1,000,000.
