**Research Analysis**

The policy committee substitute to HB 2720 creates the Targeted Violence Prevention Act. The measure authorizes the Department of Homeland Security and the Oklahoma Counter Terrorism Intelligence Center to collect, analyze, and disseminate information to law enforcement and public safety agencies regarding individuals reasonably suspected of involvement in terrorism, targeted violence, threats to public safety, or any other threats of organized or violent crime.
