Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2741 provides that a nonresident that owns a minimum of 160 acres of noncommercial lands in Oklahoma may show proof of land ownership and taxes paid on the property to qualify for specific exemptions. A nonresident who fits these criteria and paid taxes to the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation will be exempt from the annual nonresident hunting licenses.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 2741 modifies nonresident hunting licensing requirements for those nonresidents who own more than One Hundred Sixty (160) acres of land in the state and wish to hunt only on their own land. The Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation may see a slight decrease in revenue generated from those nonresidents who would now qualify for a hunting license exemption. Since the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation is a non-appropriated state agency, this measure would have no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
