**Research Analysis**

The second proposed committee substitute for HB2780 creates the Prison Acquisition Revolving Fund for the Department of Corrections (DOC) to purchase a prison from a private prison contractor. The bill also updates the list of facilities maintained by the DOC by removing the Oklahoma City Community Corrections Center and North Fork Correction Center from the list and adding the purchased prison to said list.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The FULLPCS2 to HB2780 authorizes the Department of Corrections (DOC) for the acquisition and maintenance of a facility purchased pursuant to the provisions of enrolled House Bill No. 2780 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature. The expected price of the facility is \$312,000,000, however the measure does not directly provide the funding for such acquisition.
