Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB2790 appropriates \$10 million from the Statewide Recovery Fund to the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) to provide academic, social and emotional services for young Oklahomans.

The measure also creates the Statewide Recovery Special Account for the OJA, provides that the OJA cannot spend more than 2 percent of the funds on administrative costs, and requires the OJA to submit quarterly report the Legislature on its expenditures and contracts.

HB 2790 appropriates Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) from the Statewide Recovery Fund to the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) to support increased costs related to capital projects funded through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. These are existing funds that were transferred back to the Statewide Recovery Fund and do not represent new or additional funding.
