Research Analysis

The committee amendment for HB 2897 revises the minimum font size for the text 48 points instead of 72 points.

HB 2897 requires every medical marijuana dispensary or any place those products are sold to post and display a printed sign that meets specific size requirements near checkout and at least two other highly visible places. The sign must read "WARNING: INGESTING THC PRODUCTS WHILE PREGNANT IS NOT HEALTH FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN UNBORN CHILD." The signage will be produced at the expense of the business owner.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2897 requires medical marijuana businesses to display a warning sign with specific language regarding the consumption of THC products while pregnant. The amendment modifies the minimum font size for the text. The cost of signage is at the expense of the business owner. Therefore, HB 2897 is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
