**Research Analysis**

HB 2938 as introduced, prohibits individuals that move to another state or country, whether permanently or for an indefinite amount of time, from voting in Oklahoma state, county, or municipal elections. Individuals who move temporarily or individuals and their spouses who are employed by the federal or state government and are placed out of state for work are exempt from this provision.
