Research Analysis

The policy committee amendment for HB 2945 clarifies that except for exceptions listed in the measure, a person must not knowingly manufacture or distribute an abortion-inducing drug in the state or knowingly mail, transport, deliver, prescribe, furnish the means to procure, or provide an abortion-inducing drug in any manner to or from any person or location in the state.

HB 2945 creates the "Protecting Moms and Babies Act," which prohibits a person from knowingly manufacturing or distributing an abortion-inducing drug in the state or providing an abortion-inducing drug in any manner to or from any person or location in the state. This does not apply in the case the act is done with the intent to save the life or preserve the health of an unborn child; remove a dead, unborn child whose death was caused by a miscarriage, or remove an ectopic pregnancy. A civil action under this act will not be brought upon the woman upon an abortion was performed or attempted or a pregnant woman who intends to or seeks an abortion; a common carrier who unknowingly transports a pregnant woman to an abortion provider; or a person who has abortion-inducing drugs for the purposes specified in the act. This act may only be enforced through a qui tam action, the details of which are covered in this measure.
