Research Analysis

The floor amendment to HB2964 allows fees to be assessed, but removes the requirements that fees be assessed to people accessing their medical records. If fees are assessed, the amount charged can only be up to the amount already listed in statute.

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN FLOOR SUBSTITUTE AND INTRODUCED VERSIONS

The floor substitute provides that if a fee is assessed the amount charged can only be up to the fee amount provided in statute.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2964 removes the mandatory fee for copies of medical records requested by attorneys, insurance companies, or through subpoenas. Providers may now charge up to the statutory maximum at their discretion. This change does not have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
