Research Analysis

HB 2977 authorizes Service Oklahoma to place a hidden disability indicator on the driver license or identification card upon the voluntary election of an applicant. The indicator may not include text describing the disability.

Fiscal Analysis

Service Oklahoma currently offers disability indicators on driver licenses and identification cards for hearing impairment and autism, and an epilepsy indicator will take effect June 1, 2026. As written, this measure would create a new “hidden disability” indicator that may duplicate or overlap with existing and authorized indicators, potentially causing confusion and requiring system and credential updates. If implemented as an additional indicator, Service Oklahoma estimates a one-time cost of approximately \$100,000 to modify credential design, testing, and production specifications.
