**Research Analysis**

HB 2979 directs the Department of Transportation to establish 45 mph school zones on portions of state highways upon the request of a local jurisdiction. The highway must meet certain conditions. The Department is to erect appropriate signage with maintenance and cost of operation to be the responsibility of the local jurisdiction.
