Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee recommendation to HB 2992 requires that all electric customers are subject to fair, just, and reasonable rates with costs and revenues assigned and allocated in accordance with cost causation principles. *Cost causation* means customers that are responsible for the electric supplier incurring the cost should be allocated their equitable share of those costs.

This measure requires all electric suppliers to establish and maintain separate terms, conditions, and tariffs for electric service applicable to any large load customer. The term of service for a large load customer must be at least ten (10) years.

This measure applies to all electric suppliers serving load in the state, including investor-owned utilities regulated by the Corporation Commission, electric cooperatives, municipal electric utilities, and independent power producers. This measure also authorizes the Corporation Commission to promulgate rules to effectuate the provision of this section and requires electric suppliers to comply with this act as a condition of providing service to large load customers.
