

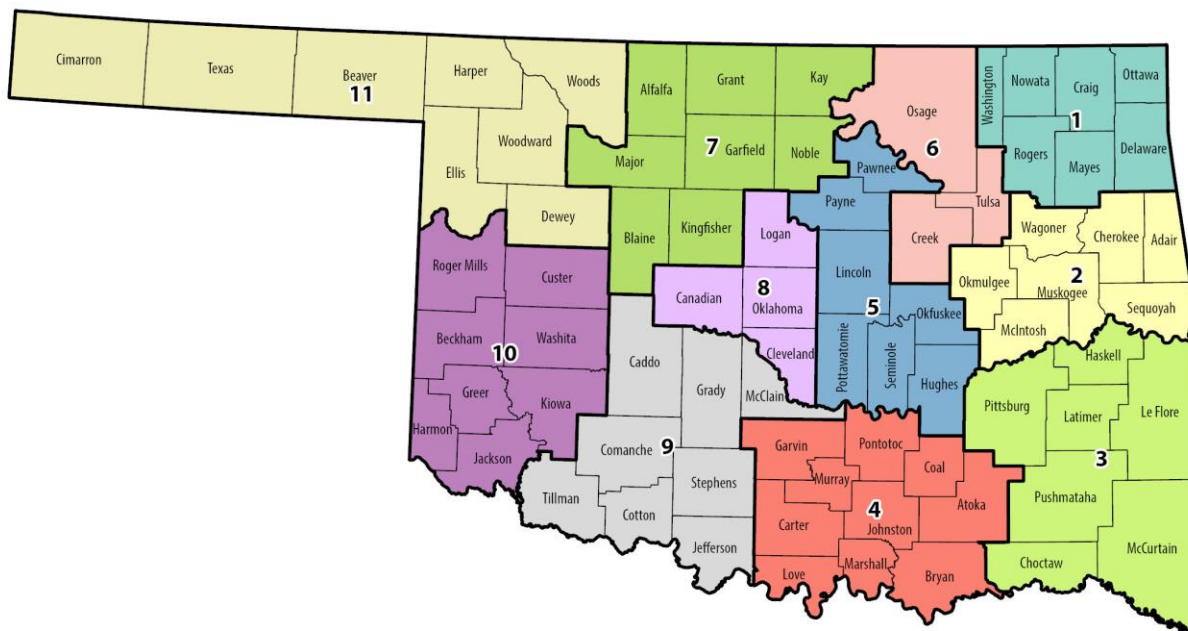

**Research Analysis**

The Policy Committee Substitute to HB 2993 creates the Rural Law Enforcement Coordination Act. The measure directs the Department of Homeland Security to administer a rural law enforcement coordination program for purposes of improving law enforcement services in the rural parts of this state. The measure establishes 11 districts and provides that the regional councils are to appoint a law enforcement coordinator for each district. The coordinator must have at least 10 years of active law enforcement experience or be a current peace officer with experience in law enforcement, law enforcement administration, or grant management. The duties and responsibilities of the law enforcement coordinators is outlined. The Rural Law Enforcement Coordination Revolving Fund is established to be used for the payment of personnel, operating expenses of the rural law enforcement coordination districts.

**HB 2993 creates 11 rural law enforcement coordination districts.**
