Research Analysis

HB 2997 increases from \$1,000 to \$10,000 the administrative fine assessed by the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle, Dismantler, and Manufactured Housing Commission against any applicant or licensee who knowingly or willfully makes any false statement of a fact. The measure increases the maximum number of full-time equivalent employees of the Oklahoma New Motor Vehicle Commission from 6 to 12, and the number of full-time equivalent employees of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle, Dismantler, and Manufactured Housing Commission from 15 to 18.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 2997 increases the maximum allowable fine for certain violations. While this may result in increased fine revenue, collections are discretionary and cannot be reliably estimated. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
