Fiscal Analysis

In its current form, HB 3015 authorizes Service Oklahoma to issue electronic credentials as an extension of a physical driver license, permit, or identification card. The measure defines relevant terms, requires rule promulgation and provides that electronic credentials may be accepted as a valid form of identification where a physical driver license is accepted.

Per Service Oklahoma, the provisions of HB 3015 authorize, but do not require, issuance of electronic credentials and that electronic credentials may be accepted as a valid for of identification where a driver license is accepted. The agency currently possesses the authority and operational framework necessary to administer digital credentialing within existing resources. The measure does not mandate implementation of a specific platform, require new staffing, or establish additional fees or exemptions. Any rulemaking, policy adjustments, or administrative actions associated with this measure can be absorbed within existing appropriations.
