HB 3016, as introduced, requires the State Department of Education and the State Department of Health to create a two-year pilot program that provides vision screenings to students in kindergarten through third grade in order to identify convergence insufficiency disorders. The screenings would be performed by trained professionals within the first 30 days of school.
