Research Analysis

HB 3031, as introduced, requires the State Department of Education to create and maintain a course numbering system for all high school courses that count toward graduation and align with Oklahoma Academic Standards.

The measure suggests a six-digit composition where the first two digits identify the main subject such as mathematics or ELA; the second set of two digits represent the set of Oklahoma Academic Standards within subject that align with the course such as Algebra 1, Literature, Economics; and the final two numbers are used to differentiate between class sections for the same course.

The system must be developed by March 31, 2027 and implemented starting the 2027–2028 school year. The bill also creates a 7-member waiver panel to review and approve courses that don't fully align with state standards.
