Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3032 requires parents to fill out an application for free or reduced price meals as part of the school enrollment process. Alternatively, a parent may fill out an opt-out form created by the State Department of Education.

Students attending a school that participates in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), as provided by federal law, are not required to fill out the form. Further, students who are certified for free meals through direct certification are also exempt from filling out the form.
