HB 3037 as introduced, covers students under the Governmental Tort Claims Act who are enrolled in a college within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education and actively participating in a faculty supervised curriculum or activity required for course credit.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3037 amends the Governmental Tort Claims Act to provide that certain students engaged in institution-sponsored academic activities are considered employees for purposes of the Act. Such amendatory language is definitional and does not create new programs, require additional appropriations, or alter state revenue sources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
