Research Analysis

HB3041, as introduced, permits sellers to apply a credit card surcharge equal to the greater of 2 percent of the transaction amount or the actual processing cost. Current law caps the surcharge at 2 percent, even when processing costs exceed that limit.

Fiscal Analysis

As introduced, HB3041 increases the credit card surcharge that sellers are allowed to apply to transactions. Sellers may apply a surcharge equal to the greater of 2 percent of the transaction amount or the actual processing cost. This measure is not expected to directly impact state revenue or state appropriations.
