**Research Analysis**

The policy committee amendment 2 to HB 3056 unstrikes subsection (A) and inserts into subsection (B) at page 2, section 1, lines 9.5 the following: *Any producer or seller of raw, unpasteurized milk, sold pursuant to this section, shall not be liable for any incidental illness due to the consumption of raw, unpasteurized milk by a consumer.*

**Fiscal Analysis**

The second policy amendment to HB 3056 adds language that prohibits producers or sellers of raw, unpasteurized milk from being liable for consumer illness related to the consumption of said milk. Upon review, this amendment has no impact on the current fiscal analysis of this measure.
