Fiscal Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3057 amends statutory language to repeal certain obsolete or unnecessary reporting requirements. The measure does not appropriate funds and is expected to reduce administrative workload for affected state agencies. The changes are potentially cost-saving to such agencies. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
