Research Analysis

HB 3069, as introduced, removes the requirement for charter school applicants to first submit their applications to the local school district. An applicant could submit their first application to another appropriate sponsor listed in statute instead. The measure provides the sponsor with 90 days to approve or reject the application. An applicant could submit a revised application with 30 days of notice of rejection, and the sponsor would have 30 days to respond to that revised application.
