Research Analysis

The second proposed committee substitute for HB 3076 allows teachers to receive certification through alternative teacher preparation programs, including programs provided by public schools, regional service agencies, and private or not-for-profit entities.

Any program operated by a private or non-profit entity must be fully accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation or the Association for Advancing Quality in Educator Preparation within three years of approval, or risk having their approval revoked.

The Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability will administer the program. The CEQA must issue a request for information from potential program operators, and provide them with application information. The Commission has 60 days to approve or deny any applications, and must provide denied applicants the opportunity to remedy any deficiencies.

Lastly, the Commission is required to promote these alternative preparation programs to potential teachers, and the State Board of Education must post a list of approved providers on their website.
